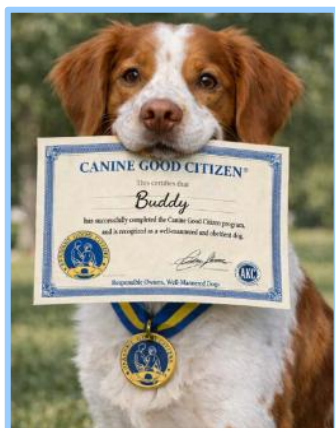

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN

Requires completion of **ALL TEN** of the tests listed below.

1. Accepting a friendly stranger
2. Sitting politely for petting
3. Appearance and grooming
4. Out for a walk (walking on a loose lead)
5. Walking through a crowd
6. Sit and down on cue and stay in place
7. Coming when called
8. Reaction to another dog
9. Reaction to distraction
10. Supervised separation.

TRICK DOG NOVICE

If your dog already has **Canine Good Citizen**, it counts for **5 of the 10 tricks** toward the Trick Dog Novice Title.

- Balance beam (walk on a board a few inches off the floor)
- Bark on cue ("Speak")
- Crawl (dog on belly, crawls at least 3 body lengths)
- Fetch it (ball, etc., 10ft away, bring to handler within 2 ft)
- Find it (find treat or scent item hidden under 1 cup or object)
- Get your _____. (Leash, brush, name toy)
- Get in (gets in box)
- Sits in box (on cue)
- Get on (gets on low platform or step – 4 paws)
- Hand signals (Choose one: down, sit or come)
- High five
- Hold (3 seconds)
- Jump (thru a low hoop or over a low bar)
- Kennel up (go in crate, stay until released)
- Kiss (point to cheek or back of hand)
- Paws up (2 front paws on low stool or step)
- Push-u[s] (sit, down, sit, down, sit, down)
- Shake hands
- Spin in a circle
- Touch it (hand or target stick)
- Tunnel (agility tunnel or child's tunnel)
